### DISBURSEMENT FEES

- Customers are responsible for payment of duties and taxes. When funds are not provided in advance by the customer, a fee of 2.5% (minimum of \$5.50) of the amount advanced by UPS will be charged.
- To avoid disbursement fees, call 1-800-PICK-UPS and ask about our pre-payment or EFT payment plans.

### ADDITIONAL SERVICES WHICH MAY APPLY

➤ Each additional classification line after the first 5 lines	\$ 3.50/line
➤ Import permits	\$ 22.00 each
➤ RMD – Release on Minimum Documentation (only for non-UPS shipments)	\$ 10.00
➤ C.O.D. fee for collecting brokerage charges To avoid C.O.D. fees, and expedite the customs clearance of your shipments, call 1-800-PICK-UPS and ask about setting up a UPS Brokerage Account.	\$ 4.00

Additional charges may apply for shipments requiring Governmental Department clearance.

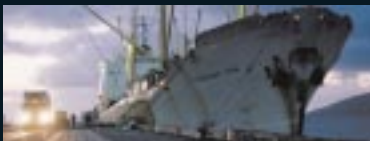
